- Ideas for professional development resources or links to post on the Title I website for other states to share.
  - Resources should be posted in original formats such as Word or PowerPoint in order to facilitate ease of use for revising/customizing to specific state needs and situations.
  - Create links to direct pages on state websites in specific areas to make it easier for other state directors to find.
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- Topics for most needed resources:
  - Title I Basic Elements Handbook for LEA new directors – states could use as a basis for customizing to specific state needs. Include specific references to statute/regulations/guidance as applicable.
  - Technical Assistance examples of how to work with other programs to fund staff and types of program delivery collaboration options.
  - Handbook/guidance on fiscal issues (MOE, comparability, supplement/not supplant)
  - Examples of guidance or use of Title I schoolwide (SW) flexibility especially related to use of funds from Title I, Title III, & IDEA
  - Parent engagement resource page (especially needed since the Parent Involvement Resource Centers are no longer funded)
  - Monitoring examples – compliance monitoring or outcome based monitoring or combination
    - Waiver/ non-waiver states
    - Sharing tools/resources
  - 1003(a) funds – how can they be used - waiver/nonwaiver
