## Attendee Welcome Reception

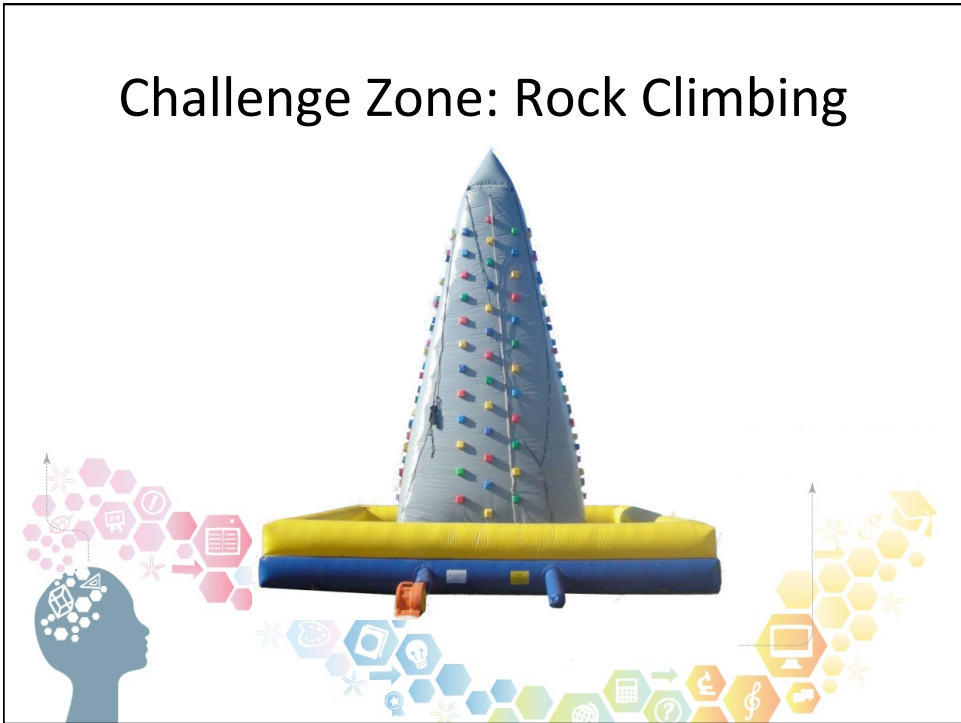
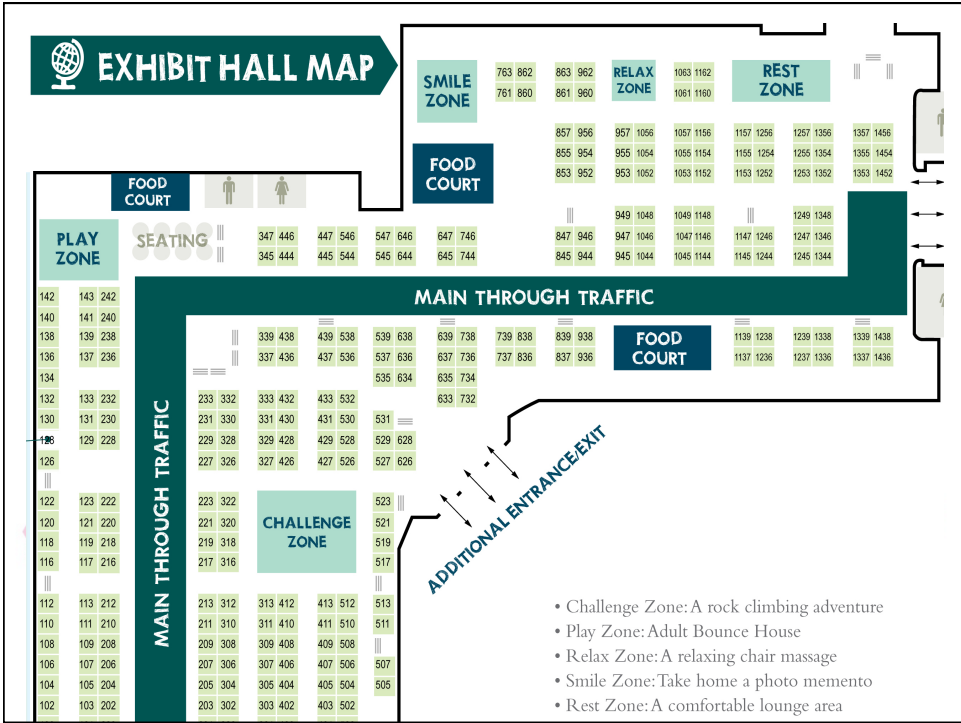

- Zones open whenever the exhibit hall is open, and during the Attendee Welcome Reception

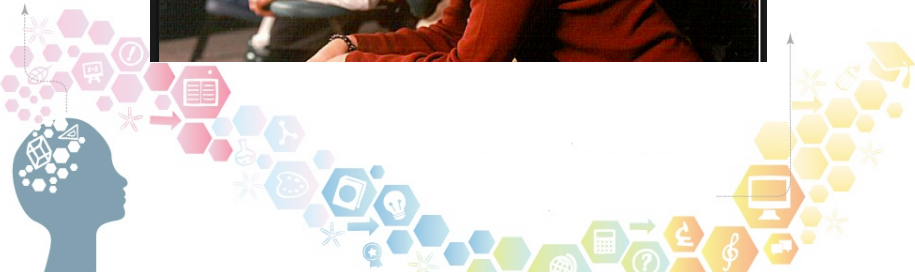

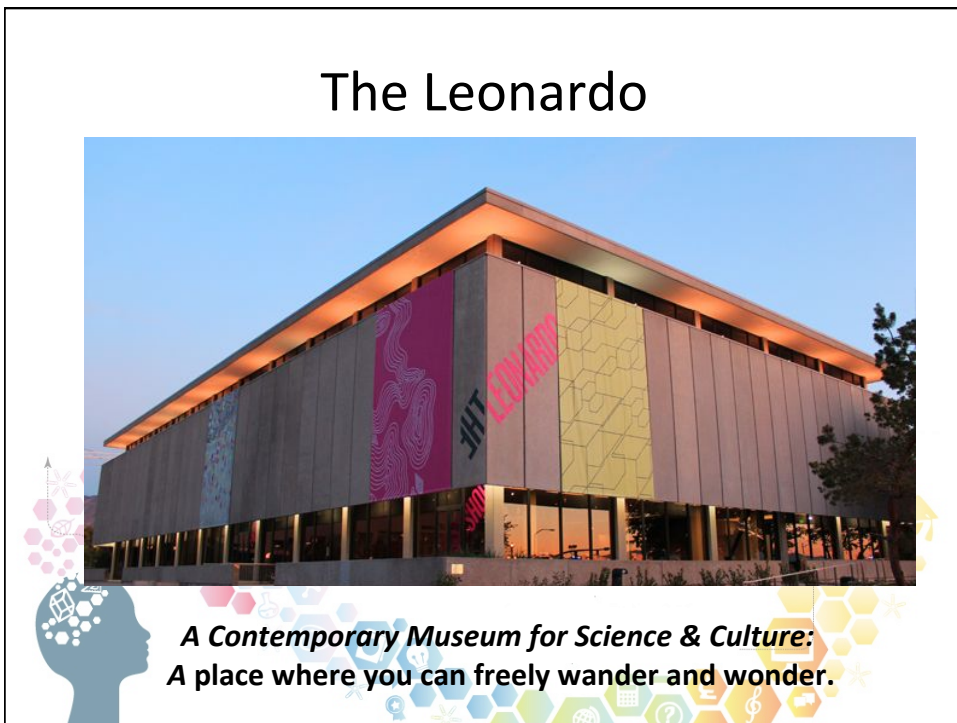

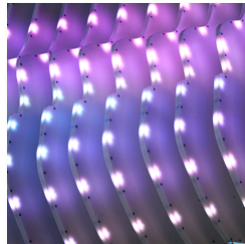
