- Helps reinforce the "ownership" of the conference in minds of the attendees



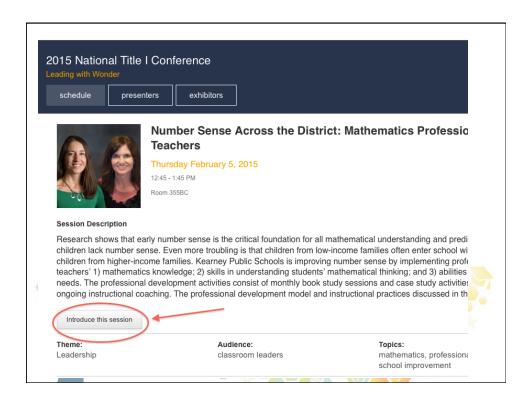
Sign Up Process
