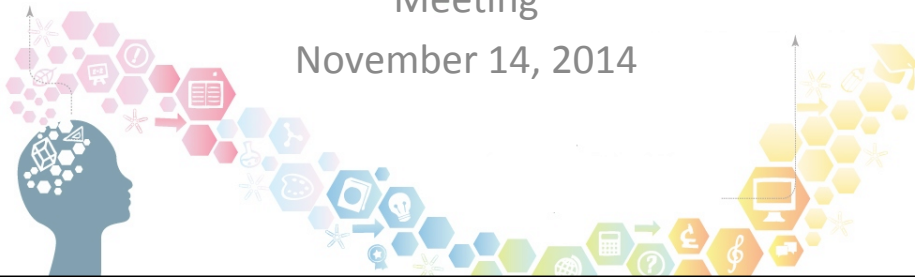

Number Sense Across the District: Mathematics Professional Development for Teachers

Session Description

Research shows that early number sense is the critical foundation for all mathematical understanding and pre-K children lack number sense. Even more troubling is that children from low-income families often enter school with less number sense than children from higher-income families. Kearney Public Schools is improving number sense by implementing professional development activities for teachers: 1) mathematics knowledge; 2) skills in understanding students' mathematical thinking; and 3) addressing individual students' needs. The professional development activities consist of monthly book study sessions and case study activities, as well as ongoing instructional coaching. The professional development model and instructional practices discussed in this session will be shared.

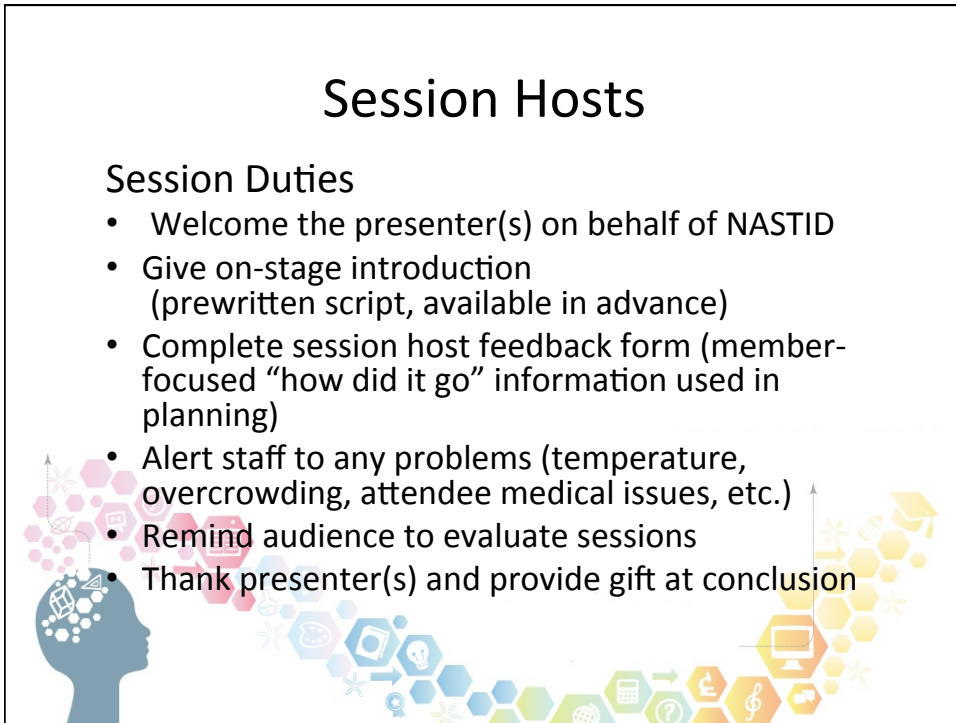
