2. Recruit proposal graders

Proposals submissions for the conference close on June 17th. The next phase in the selection process is to grade the proposals. Committee members are automatically graders. Distinguished School principals from last year will be invited to grade, as well as all NASTID members. Mike Radke suggested each committee member send a group email to all of the NASTID members from their state, asking them to
